



## CORES Certification in LIHTC Qualified Allocation Plans

CORES Certification has been included on Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) applications in a growing number of states. Read more about how different states have incorporated CORES into their QAPs, including those listed below.

*\*\*Please note that there may be other service-enriched or resident services components and/or requirements included in these and other QAPs that are not fully captured here.\*\**

### Indiana

In the 2025 QAP, an applicant may earn two competitive points if they are CORES-certified under the Direct or Hybrid model. Applicants may also receive up to 8 additional points for a commitment to provide certain services.

### New Hampshire

In the 2025-26 QAP, resident services is a threshold requirement for all 9% LIHTC projects. Instead of submitting a service coordination plan and budget, CORES is an alternative pathway for applicants to earn these threshold points.

### Georgia

In the 2024-25 QAP, applicants that are CORES-certified or commit to accept services from a CORES third-party provider may earn two competitive points for service-enriched properties.

### Maryland

In the 2023 QAP, resident services is a threshold requirement and an opportunity to earn 8 competitive points; CORES certification or working with a certified CORES third-party provider is one pathway to earn these points.

### Ohio

In the 2024-25 QAP, CORES certification or partnering with a certified CORES third-party provider is one of three possible pathways to earn 4 competitive points for new affordability – senior housing and 15 competitive points for service enriched housing.

### Virginia

In the 2024 QAP, CORES certification or working with a certified CORES third-party provider is one pathway to meet VHDA's requirement for the "Accessible Supportive Housing" Set Aside Pool.

**\*Important note:** These are high-level summaries of how CORES has been incorporated in LIHTC QAPs and should not be used as guidance when applying for tax credits.
